The Oldies Club is an organisation dedicated to helping homeless older dogs. We support dogs in foster homes until permanent homes can be found. We also assist other rescues by advertising their older dogs and by helping with home visits and transport, so dogs can be homed across the UK.



The Oldies Club is urgently looking for more foster homes who can provide temporary care for older dogs who find themselves without a home through no fault of their own.



Older dogs are handed into the Oldies Club for many reasons, sometimes due to the death of their owners, changes in commitments or where elderly owners are unable to take care of their much loved dogs any longer.



We need caring foster homes to help us give those oldies a new lease in life. Some of our dogs are rehomed within weeks of coming into our care, while some are fostered for months.

All our foster homes are home checked, and we take great care to match the right dogs to the right homes taking account of factors such as working hours, children and other pets. We give full support to our foster carers and are always on hand to help sort out any problems or give advice where needed. The Oldies Club pays for all veterinary treatment for dogs in our care.
