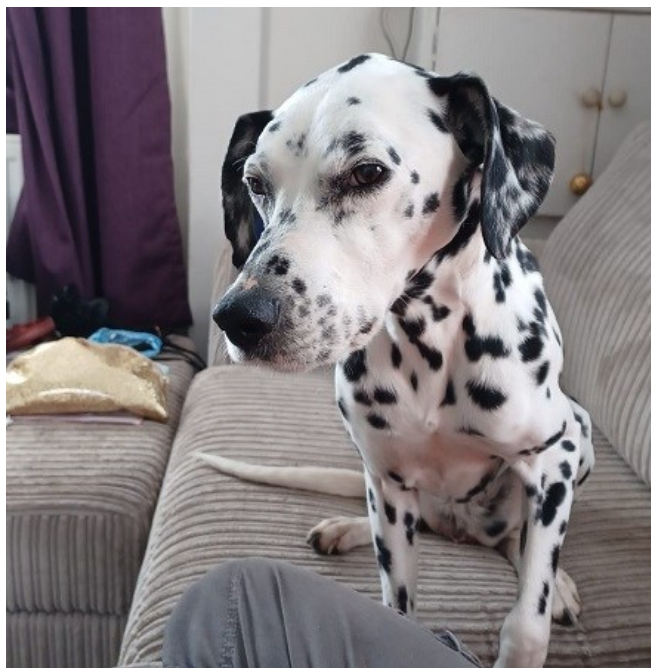


Pretty Purdy, darling Dalmatian!

She settled into the foster home very quickly and her foster carers say she is a loving, nosey and greedy dog! She loves her food but can snatch a little when receiving a treat from you. Her foster carers are working on this and her new owners need to continue the training! Purdy is being fostered in Sevenoaks, Kent.

Ideal Home : In her foster home, Purdy is happy to be left for 3-4 hours as she has another dog for company. If being homed as the only-dog, she would have to have someone around most of the day. She loves her walks although may have “selective hearing” when let off lead! Her foster carer’s are not letting her off lead unless in an enclosed area. She is having 2 walks a day for 30 to 50 minutes. Car journey are very acceptable with her, she likes new places to explore!

Children: Purdy is not living with children in her foster home, but seems very friendly to children and adults alike. But, due to her snatching food from your hand, we can’t home her with very young children.

Other Dogs: Purdy can live with another dog. She likes to meet other dogs, although she may bark to say hello.. There is no aggression in her. Just a vocal girl!

Cats: We are looking for a car-free home as we do not know how Purdy is with cats.
